TAZZ vied for the lead, bumped EXECUTIVE COACH in the upper stretch, then held off foes in the late going and prevailed. WAKEUPBRANDON vied for the lead inside, veered out sharply in the stretch and weakened. EXECUTIVE COACH vied for the lead early, was blocked, checked and bumped in the stretch which resulted in the jockey claiming foul. SORREL OF THE SEA was always close, lacked room and steadied inside during the stretch run. HELLO SAILOR was squeezed back at the start and raced widest in the stretch. HEAVENLY DUE was unhurried early and steadied late in lane when there was no room. THERE WAS A JOCKEY'S AND TRAINER'S CLAIM OF FOUL AN WAS TAKEN.
