Footnotes

FLAMING GLORY broke sharply, set the pace under light rating racing to the bend and was roused to maintain his advantage in the last furlong. HOLY THURSDAY was held up just off the pacesetter near the inside in the opening quarter, saved ground to upper stretch and proved best of the others. THIEF, carried out at the start into the path of BLYDE RIVER BOY, was quickly righted to track just off the pacesetter between foes, couldn't gain terms with the winner and just lasted for a share. TAX AND SPEND broke a bit awkwardly, was roused to regain terms with the field in the opening stages, tracked between foes just off the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out a bit in late stages and just missed for a share. HE'S HOT SAUCE was a brief factor tracking the pacesetter three deep in second flight but steadily faded nearing the lane. BLYDE RIVER BOY, bumped at the start, was collected to track outside foes off the second flight racing to the bend but offered no rally. PROFESSOR HENNESSY swerved out sharply at the start into the path of THIEF, was settled between foes racing to the turn and steadily faded from contention.
