JEREMIAH JACK contested the pace from the inside and prevailed at the end of a long drive. AISLE contested the pace three wide but could not finish with the top one. DUBAI SQUIRE vied for command between horses but could not go with the top two in the drive. CHRYSALIS COURT saved ground but was not a factor. NOTABLE EDITOR never reached a contending position. DYF was shuffled back badly at the start and was always outrun. GO CART raced off the rail near the middle of the field and tired.
