Footnotes

ITZACOLDCASE was prompted to secure a position inside a rival in the second flight tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance racing into the turn, continued with a steady response to challenge along the rail nearing midstretch, wrested command in late stages and edged forward under firm handling. RETAIL REGER settled off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, steadily gathered momentum while shifting outside foes midway through the turn, continued four deep through the stretch and split foes in late stages to narrowly prevail for place honors while closing the gap. MAJESTIC MARIA settled in last along the inside racing to the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and produced a steady late response to close the gap on the leaders inside foes while just missing for place honors. ROCKET TWENTYONE was urged clear from between foes soon after the break, set the pace on a clear margin racing into upper stretch, shifted out under nearing the furlong marker and failed to sustain her momentum. ST. LOUIS CITY, urged along pursuing the pacesetter racing into the turn, gradually drew on terms with the leader after a half, couldn't sustain her bid past the furlong marker then was taken in hand in the final stages while drifting off markedly nearing the finish line. SPANISH COMEDY was urged to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn but came up empty racing into upper stretch. DOLLY PEACH, reserved just after the start, never gained contention.
