Footnotes

OUTLAW ZEN took up a position just off the first flight under light rating while racing outside a rival in the opening quarter, continued with a steady bid to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch and wrested a narrow advantage in time under firm handling. HE GONE, forwardly placed from the outset gaining terms with a rival on the pace, prompted that foe racing into upper stretch, moved to gain the advantage nearing the furlong marker and just failed to contain the winner. JAGUAR RIDGE tracked just off the first flight along the inside under light reserve racing into the bend, awaited an opening nearing upper stretch when lacking a path from which to challenge, then switched outside foes in the closing stages to close the gap while prevailing for a share. UNCLE WAYNE moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break disputing the pace, dueled for command racing into upper stretch and yielded to the top trio in the final sixteenth. THERE'S NO TELLING settled between foes racing well off the second flight in the opening stages and continued evenly into the stretch. DANDYMAN was settled into stride outside foes in the opening stages and never gained striking distance. WIN TUCKER settled in last along the rail racing through the backstretch and never seriously menaced.
