Footnotes

SECRET STORY (IRE) hesitated at the start, settled outside a rival in the last flight in the opening half, gathered momentum while shifting out on the far turn, swung five wide in upper stretch and produced a steady late response while shifting inwards under pressure to prevail under firm handling. CASS' LADY was reserved off the second flight while angling nearer to the inside racing to the backstretch, split foes gaining position in second flight on the far turn, briefly awaited an opening entering upper stretch, then shifted four wide to bid between foes in tandem with the winner but couldn't match that rival's final kick. HARBOR SPIRIT settled into stride in the last flight racing along the rail to the far turn, switched out nearing midstretch to split foes three deep and continued with interest in a belated bid to narrowly prevail for a share. BATTLE BUSTER, pulling a bit while caught four wide nearing the first turn, tracked just off the first flight three deep racing to the second bend, moved to challenge in that path nearing midstretch, struck the front at the furlong marker but failed to sustain her momentum. MISTIE ROYALE angled in early to track the pace between foes in the second flight, was caught four wide racing through the far turn and finished evenly in that path in the last furlong. HERE OUI GO AGAIN was rated along the inside tracking just off the second flight in the opening half, saved ground on the far turn, shifted out avoiding traffic racing through the stretch but had no closing bid. VISION OF LIZ was a brief factor between foes in the second flight in the opening half, then steadied out of tight quarters midway through the far turn while giving way. BEACH CLUB was urged to the lead inside foes racing into the first turn, disputed the pace along the rail into the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch. NOYUCAN'T, forwardly placed three deep in the opening stages, prompted the pace outside a rival to the second bend, pressed the issue between foes into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker.
