Footnotes

SANTO RIO was settled into stride along the inside, shifted out entering the turn, swung six wide nearing upper stretch commencing her advance, drifted inwards under pressure making some contact with COURTESY CALL but continued with a steady late response to prevail in time. DUBAI BEAUTY sped to the fore while shifting to the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace along the rail racing into the bend, shook clear in upper stretch and just failed to contain the winner. COURTESY CALL settled outside foes off the second flight early, shifted out to bid five deep between foes nearing upper stretch, was bumped by the eventual winner leaving the three sixteenths marker and couldn't match that foe in late stages while continuing well enough to earn a share. CHILEAN DREAMS tracked the pacesetter four deep between foes in second flight racing into the bend and continued evenly in that path between foes to late stages. LITTLE WHITE STAR tracked inside foes as part of the second flight on the backstretch, lost some position on the turn, shifted to the eight path entering upper stretch and continued evenly while regaining some position. LOST FRIEND tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but retreated from contention early. SO LONG JULIE, bumped at the break, was held up three deep between foes off the second flight racing to the turn and never gained striking distance. CHE SERAI, caught five deep in the second flight racing through the backstretch, shifted inwards on the bend to lodge a brief bid nearing upper stretch but quickly emptied out. DAZZLE HER tracked the pace three wide in second flight between foes in the opening stages,

angled to the rail entering the turn and steadily faded from contention. AIR STRIPE broke inwards at the start bumping SO LONG JULIE, was switched out six wide early while being urged to contention, lodged a brief, four wide bid midway through the turn but gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
