Footnotes

AT THE FINISH, prominent between foes from the outset, pressed the pace inside a rival racing into the turn while shifting to the inside, edged forward to a clear advantage on the bend under her own courage, then responded to firm encouragement to turn back a challenge from DO DAT BLUES nearing the furlong marker to prove clearly best. The latter raced within striking distance along the inside stalking just off the leaders, steadily moved to position while shifting off the inside nearing upper stretch, tried the winner nearing the furlong marker but proved no match. I SEE MAMBO settled in last along the inside racing into the turn, shifted out to split foes entering upper stretch, then continued along the inside in an effort to improve position while earning a share. SILKY SAMI settled into stride shifting off the inside early, continued with a steady effort to split foes three wide entering upper stretch and continued evenly. NAUGHTY AND NICE tracked just off the leaders along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed closing bid. CONGOTOWN joined the pace four deep soon after the break, forced the pace outside the eventual winner racing into the turn and gave way after a half. HELLO LOVE vied briefly three deep between foes in the opening quarter but dropped out of contention early.
