BAYVILLE saved ground near the middle of the field, rallied up the rail in the stretch, steadied when in tight late then came on for the place when clear. TOO MANY CHOICES raced close up inside and lacked a winning bid. NO CHIT CHAT set the pace from just outside while pressed and weakened. SPRINGS ETERNAL broke in the air and improved her position in the drive. SHADOW GREEN also improved her position without threatening. ROLLING HOME was never a factor. SUPREM DREAM was through early. CROWNING DIABLO was always outrun.
