ANEGADA lacked speed, came out six wide for the drive and won going away under a brisk hand ride. JENNIE R. raced inside near the middle of the field and rallied for the place while not a threat. POETS AND ANGELS stalked the pace from off the rail and weakened a bit. BOLD TWISTER raced close up off the rail and lacked a bid. MORE THAN PROMISED lacked speed three wide and was not a factor. EXTRAVAGANT GAL raced near the middle of the field and weakened. GRAND ILLUSION lacked speed inside and failed to reach contention. SEA SIREN raced three wide and gave way. PATRICIA'S SECRET set the pace from the inside on a clear lead and tired. MISS CONNIE SUE was always outrun. (Race run in lane 1, rail out 6 feet.).
