FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND OLDER. Nominations close Wednesday, July 25, 2007 with no fee. A supplementary nomination may be made at time of entry for \$500 which includes entry and starting fees. \$150 to enter and \$150 additional to start with \$45,000 added of which 60% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight; Three year olds 121 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Winners of \$60,000 in 2007, 2 lbs. extra. Non-winners of \$35,000 once or \$28,000 twice in 2007 allowed 2 lbs. Of \$30,000 once or \$20,000 twice since November 1, 4 lbs. Of \$24,000 since September 1, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered.) The field will be limited to 12 starters. Highweights on the scale preferred. Total earnings in 2006 / 2007 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Nominations Closed Wednesday, July 25, 2007 with 22.

CITY NUMBER was slow early, dueled thru the stretch and gamely prevailed. STAR BY DESIGN void early speed, made a quick move in the turn, dueled thru the lane and just missed. HIGH EXPECTATIONS was void early speed then closed with a rush. GRANDE COEUR was never far back, had a brief lead then faded. FIFTEEN ROUNDS raced evenly and lacked a late response. CELLULOID HERO stalked the pace and failed to sustain the bid. HUMOR AT LAST set a pressured pace and faltered, and was bumped in the late stretch. ALABAMA CLAY had speed for half, was bumped and stopped in the stretch.
