Footnotes

ALBIN was settled into stride outside foes in the opening half, gradually drew into striking distance racing four deep leaving the second bend, was fanned five wide in upper stretch but produced a solid late response to wrest command and edge clear in time under firm handling. I'LL SHOW THEM, reserved well off the second flight in hand in the opening half, made steady progress three deep entering the far turn to gain striking distance nearing upper stretch, moved to challenge four deep between foes nearing midstretch, struck the front between calls leaving the furlong marker but came up second best when confronted by the winner. DAVID D, reserved outside a rival in the second flight while carried out a bit nearing the backstretch, continued under patient handling tracking the leaders in hand to the second bend, moved to challenge three deep entering upper stretch but couldn't fend off the top pair late. PEYTONVILLE, reserved in last racing along the rail to the far turn, angled outside foes nearing upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing four deep. MUSICSTREET MENACE, reserved while guided to the inside in early stages, shifted out to split foes entering the far turn, gained some position entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. CROWN OF ARAGORN, urged to the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, dueled for

command along the inside entering the far turn, then gave way in upper stretch. HERO'S AND CROOKS was urged to prompt the pace outside a rival in the opening quarter, angled to the inside entering the backstretch to track just off the leaders but steadily retreated from contention on the far turn. LIONDRIVE, close up along the inside racing as part of the second flight while under some reserve in the opening stages, was steadied a bit nearing the six furlong marker, shifted off the inside to split foes three deep, moved to press a rival on the pace racing through the backstretch into the far turn, gained a narrow advantage midway through the second bend but quickly emptied out in upper stretch.
