BOWMAN'S SECRET broke sharply to secure a narrow advantage along the inside, dictated a measured pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, shook clear when prompted entering upper stretch and widened his advantage to the end under steady pressure. STATIC KILL was settled outside foes five deep in early stages, commenced a steady advance racing four wide on the turn, continued in that path through the stretch with a solid response and prevailed for place honors. SENATOR DAVE worked his way to the rail while settling inside foes in the last flight early, saved ground on the turn, shifted out to split foes near the inside in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while outfinished for second. COME ON MAN, forwardly placed from the outset attending his entymate's pace, couldn't match that foe after a half and weakened racing through the stretch. BINGORUN broke slowly while shifting inwards bumping FULLCOURTPRESSURE, was collected off that foe, raced unhurried between foes in the last flight early, shifted out on the bend, was caught five wide nearing upper stretch but made an effort to improve his position in that path racing into the stretch. SHOOT THE LOOP shifted out in early stages tracking well off the second flight, angled in to race between foes on the turn but steadily faded from contention entering upper stretch, then returned to be unsaddled without his rider's whip. FULLCOURTPRESSURE broke slowly and was bumped at the start, was urged to gain a position along the inside tracking the leaders but steadily retreated entering upper stretch. POLAR EXPEDITION angled inwards to track just off the first flight racing into the turn but came up empty after a half. GRACIES BRUDDER flashed brief pace three deep but was spent after three furlongs.
