Footnotes

DELIGHTFUL DAISY went to the fore while angling to the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin while under light rating into the far turn, then responded to steady handling and a few right handed taps to edge forward of WOODY'S BLUFF in the closing stages. The latter broke sharply, was taken in hand to stalk the pacesetter along the inside racing into the first turn, shifted out entering the backstretch while moving to closer terms with the pacesetter while under rating, increased the tempo on the far turn to press the issue racing into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. D D'S KIDDING, forwardly placed outside a rival stalking the pacesetter under some reserve in the opening stages, was taken back off the leaders entering the backstretch to track outside a rival in the second flight, continued unhurried into the second bend, angled out four wide in upper stretch and made a steady late effort to close the gap and earn a share. SANDI'S READY raced unhurried between foes in the last flight in the opening half, angled to the rail on the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch but offered no rally. JAZZ ODYSSEY, reserved along the inside from just out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted out entering the far turn while moving to challenge three deep but quickly flattened out nearing midstretch. HELLO AGAIN, reserved outside foes three deep racing to the backstretch, was caught, five, then four wide entering the second bend and quickly dropped out of contention.
