Footnotes

YUKAN B CLASSY TOO gained a position along the inside tracking just off the first flight under some reserve racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady response near the inside on the far turn to gain second racing into upper stretch, shifted out racing through the lane but produced a sustained response to prevail in time under firm encouragement. CAST A COLD EYE, pulling a bit while gaining a forward placing three deep racing into the first turn, took over nearing the far turn, moved well clear after six furlongs while shifting to the inside, held sway past the furlong marker but couldn't contain the winner. DAKOTA MILKSHAKE angled inwards racing to the first turn to track between foes off the second flight, then continued with a steady effort to improve his position and gain a share in late stages while failing to threaten the top pair. REGGIVILLE, urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily weakened after losing the lead nearing the far turn. IRON CHAMP tracked the leaders unhurried three deep racing off the second flight in the opening half, continued in that path entering the far turn while making an effort to improve position and was outfitted for a share. BIG POPPA D, bumped at the start, settled well off the field in the opening half and never gained striking distance. STAR ACCOUNTANT broke outwards at the start, was held up when racing in tight quarters between foes entering the first turn and never mounted a serious challenge. IKAROS tracked the pace unhurried along the inside from well off the second flight early and never seriously menaced. GREAT BAM, bumped, then squeezed between foes at the start, was righted quickly to track between foes racing to the backstretch but quickly came up empty racing into the far turn. WILDWOOD ARAGORN broke inwards bumping BIG POPPA D, was quickly collected to prompt the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn but was spent after a half.
