Footnotes

SMARTER STILL was prompted to gain a position in the second flight while angling to the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out three deep nearing the far turn, continued with a steady bid to gain striking distance racing into upper stretch and edged BOMBINO in time under steady encouragement. The latter, four deep early, was urged to gain a position in the second flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress entering the far turn to close the gap on the pacesetter, moved to wrest command from that foe leaving the furlong marker but proved no match for the winner. DALAXY worked his way to the inside while settling well off the second flight, shifted out on the backstretch, made steady progress entering the second bend, was shuffled a bit in close quarters midway through the second bend, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to close the gap and earn a share. RELVADO, unhurried between foes in the opening stages, made some progress splitting rivals on the far turn to gain striking distance in upper

stretch but lacked the needed final kick. SHINE THE ROCKET, reserved saving ground in the opening half, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. STRONG LUCK was urged to the lead from between foes racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin while pulling his rider along racing into the second bend, briefly resisted when challenged racing into upper stretch but emptied out in late stages. ESPRESSO tracked off the second flight along the inside under some reserve in the opening half, was steadied off a tiring foe approaching the far turn, shifted off the inside on the far turn and continued evenly to late stages. COURTLY, forwardly placed three deep racing to the backstretch, emptied out quickly along the inside racing through the far turn. BLUE DAY IN MAY, held up out of tight quarters at the start, never mounted a serious challenge. TAXCO was never a factor. ONE MORE TAP raced between foes off the second flight but steadily faded after a half. CANDY KIN flashed brief pace along the inside racing to the backstretch but was spent early.
