**Footnotes**

GLENCO KID was reserved just out of striking distance four deep in the second flight racing through the backstretch, advanced in that path nearing upper stretch to challenge the leaders, wrested command nearing the sixteenth marker and edged clear late under firm handling. JACK N JOHN gained terms with a rival attending the pace in the opening stages, continued between foes under light rating racing into the bend, was urged to dispute the issue outside a rival in upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner's final bid. ROI GEORGE pulled his way to the fore while angling to the inside in the opening stages, attended the tempo racing into the bend under some reserve, was urged to dispute the issue nearing upper stretch and yielded to the top pair leaving the furlong marker. MY BOURBON BUY settled off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half, split foes racing into upper stretch, then shifted out late while making an effort to improve position. KITCHI WARRIOR, bumped, then carried into the path of WICENTY at the start, was reserved off the second flight, shifted to the inside nearing the turn but couldn't produce the needed closing response. ALLIED broke slowly, settled along the inside but never gained contention. FLY BOY ROY broke inwards bumping KITCHI WARRIOR, was righted to track between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. WICENTY, forced inwards a bit at the start, was righted to track just off the first flight along the inside in the opening half under rating, shifted out on the turn to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. SOUTHERN QUIET, within striking distance four deep in the opening stages, continued in that path racing into the bend, was fanned five wide nearing upper stretch and steadily faded from contention.
