Footnotes

TWYLAS RED CAT, prominent three deep from the outset, attended the pace under light rating racing into the bend, steadily asserted himself racing into upper stretch while being edged clear in late stages under firm handling. TIZ A SCHOLAR tracked the pace four deep off the second flight in the opening stages, made steady progress in that path on the turn to challenge nearing upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but proved best of the others. SALUTING STORMYE moved to the fore along the inside in the opening quarter to join the pace, dueled for command along the rail to upper stretch and weakened late when failing to match the top pair. DAVID D tracked just off the first flight near the inside under rating racing into the bend, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted off the inside to bid between foes but had no final kick. TSUNAMI KING tracked the pace three deep behind the second flight racing to the turn, angled outside foes entering upper stretch and continued evenly. JOHNNY CADILLAC, a bit outpaced early, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. IZZY GOLDEN, prominent between foes from the break, dueled between foes to upper stretch and gave way. PERFECT CASTING worked his way to the inside early tracking off the second flight and lacked a closing response. HAMMERS BULLET was a brief factor between foes in second flight but steadily faded on the turn.
