Footnotes

COURSEUR broke sharply to gain terms with several foes on the lead, attended the pace between foes under light rating racing into the bend, steadily asserted herself racing into upper stretch and went clear late under firm handling. I O CASHEL tracked just off the first flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out three wide nearing midstretch while being urged to advance and proved best of the others while no threat to the winner. COURTING DELILAH, within striking distance three deep in the opening stages, pressed the issue in that path racing into upper stretch, was fanned four wide nearing the furlong marker and faded in late stages. LIMEHOUSE DANCER, urged to the lead along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. STEPHANIE'S CAILIN tracked off the first flight from just out of striking distance and continued evenly off the inside into the stretch. WIN'EM ALL ducked inwards, then was steadied a bit at the start, was righted to track the leaders from out of striking distance along the inside but lacked a closing response. SWEET STORMY hopped at the start, was settled between foes in the last flight racing to the turn and offered no rally. TATTIE KAT settled into stride along the inside early and never seriously menaced. AMERICAN SONATA raced four wide well off the second flight in the opening quarter and had no response despite some pressure.
