### Footnotes

AWESOME ATTACK was settled outside a rival racing well out of striking position in the opening half, came under pressure to advance while shifting out four wide on the turn, continued in that path into upper stretch and produced a solid late response to reel in MY JOKESTER to gain a clear advantage near the wire under firm handling. The latter pulled his way to the fore outside a rival in the opening stages, dictated the pace under rating on the bend, forged clear racing into upper stretch but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. SPORTING HOLIDAY settled into stride along the inside in last on the backstretch, shifted a bit off the inside to split foes racing into upper stretch and produced his best stride late to gain a share nearest the rail. KID CHIC, reserved off the second flight in the opening half, moved to challenge splitting foes nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. EMPIRE SHOES tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight racing into the turn but came up empty nearing upper stretch. SKY BLUE MONGOLIA moved to the fore along the inside in the opening stages, relinquished the lead to track a rival along the inside racing into the turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. FRANKIE IS ROCK was a brief factor tracking in second flight along the inside racing through the backstretch but was through after a half.
