Footnotes

CREPE MYRTLE broke outwards bumping, then shifted into the path of VICTORY BABY after the break, was settled into stride racing out of striking distance to the backstretch, made a steady advance on the leaders through the far turn, angled inside a rival entering upper stretch while continuing well, then shifted out in the final sixteenth to challenge three deep while making some contact with CATCH THAT KITTEN but narrowly prevailed under firm handling. SWEET TIZZY LIZZY secured terms with a rival on the pace along the inside racing to the backstretch, dueled for command into the far turn, gained a narrow advantage on the second bend, resisted several rivals to late stages and was just collared on the wire. CATCH THAT KITTEN bobbed at the start, recovered quickly to gain a forward placing between foes racing to the backstretch, stalked just outside the first flight to the second bend, bid three wide for command racing through the far turn, continued to dispute the issue between foes in late stages while being brushed by the winner late and was narrowly outfinished. INSIDE DEAL, rank against restraint racing along the inside while just behind the leaders in the opening stages, responded to rating tactics on the backstretch to track the leaders in second flight along the inside, shifted out to make a brief bid between foes midway through the second bend but failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. VICTORY BABY broke a bit awkwardly while exchanging bumps with the eventual winner just after the break, settled along the inside to the backstretch, switched out nearing upper stretch to race four wide in the lane and made some mild progress late. WILDCAT MISS broke sharply despite being bumped at the start, forced the pace outside a rival into the backstretch, pressed the pace for six furlongs and gave way midway through the far turn. MY KENTUCKY BREEZE never seriously menaced.
