Footnotes

STANLEY G. shifted nearer to the inside in early stages while taking up a position leading the second flight in hand from well out of striking distance, continued under reserve to the second bend, shifted off the inside making steady progress racing into upper stretch, took charge nearing the furlong marker and drew away under steady encouragement. GIANT SHIFT settled outside a rival in the last flight early, shifted outside foes entering the far turn gradually gathering momentum, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and produced a steady late response to prevail for place honors. CARTOUCHE tracked the leaders outside foes in second flight in the opening half, shifted out nearing upper stretch and made some mild progress racing four deep between foes. BERLIOZ was hustled to the lead along the inside soon after the break, disputed the pace to the far turn, then into upper stretch and gave way nearing the furlong marker once headed by the winner. COPPER FOREST, urged to dispute the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, pressed the issue in an extended skirmish racing into upper stretch and gave way nearing the furlong marker. BOOM BOOM CHARLIE hopped at the start, settled into stride along the inside racing to the backstretch but never gained contention. PLYMOUTH BAY required a shoe repair in the paddock, worked his way to the inside tracking the leaders as part of the second flight in the opening half but steadily faded from contention entering the far turn.
