**Footnotes**

STEPHANIE'S KITTEN broke readily, was taken in hand nearing the first turn to be reserved off the leaders, lost some position to those foes on the backstretch while continuing under patient handling, commenced a steady advance when given her cue entering the far turn, shifted off the inside while moving to striking distance nearing upper stretch, quickly took charge approaching the furlong marker and held sway to the end while appearing to switch leads in the final strides. RAINBOW BLOSSOM, reserved along the inside from just out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted off the inside midway through the far turn, split foes racing into upper stretch following the winner's path, made some effort to close the gap but couldn't gain terms with the winner while proving clearly best of the others. A. P. AZERIN, urged to secure a forward placing four wide racing to the first turn, joined the pace three deep entering the backstretch, pressed the issue in that path nearing the far turn to gain a clear advantage after six furlongs but proved no match when confronted by the top two. ANNIE RUSSELL settled off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted outside foes entering the far turn while being urged to contention but couldn't produce the needed final response. TRIPPING, pulling a bit in the opening stages, moved to terms with several rivals on the pace while between foes racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue between foes into the far turn and gave way in the drive. JILL GOLDEN tracked the leaders unhurried outside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch but came up empty entering the far turn. LADY JOBURG was urged to the lead along the inside from the outset, dueled for command into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs.
