Footnotes

DISTANT BUGLE broke sharply to secure a narrow advantage outside a rival in the opening stages, shifted to the rail dictating the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, dueled for command in upper stretch to late stages and gamely held the challenge of CAN'T STOP RAVIN under firm left handed pressure. The latter gained terms with the leader while shifting outside that foe attending the pace under light rating in the opening stages, steadily increased the pressure racing into upper stretch to dispute the issue to the end and was just outfinished. MILITARY LEGEND settled outside foes from out of striking distance early, made steady progress while angling four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to close the gap late. MILWAUKEE WOLF tracked off the first flight along the inside racing into the bend, shifted out three deep in upper stretch to bid between foes but lacked the needed final response. DICTUM settled into stride along the rail in the opening stages and never gained contention. FOREST RUN was a brief factor outside a rival racing as part of the second flight in the opening stages but steadily retreated racing into the stretch.
