### Footnotes

MIDNIGHT LACE pulled her way to terms with a rival on the lead racing into the first turn while under firm reserve, attended the pace in that fashion to the second bend, was urged to force the issue racing into upper stretch and narrowly prevailed on the wire under firm encouragement in a prolonged drive. ORIGINAL KITTEN broke readily to secure the advantage along the rail racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin while in hand for five furlongs, resisted the winner's bid when challenged racing into upper stretch and grudgingly disputed the issue to the end to just miss. PENELOPE PERFECT moved to secure a forward placing three deep while under light rating in the opening stages, stalked just off the leaders in that position to the second bend, briefly pressed the issue racing into upper stretch but weakened in late stages when failing to match the top pair. HARLAN SHOWGIRL, firmly rated between foes just off the first flight in the opening half, continued between foes to the second bend, then altered course five deep nearing midstretch while making some belated progress. ANNACLONE tracked just off the leaders along the inside under light rating racing to the second bend, shifted a bit off the inside racing into upper stretch to challenge but had no final kick. DREAMS DIE FIRST tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, angled four wide racing through the far turn while being prompted to advance but had no final response while finishing under intermittent pressure. APPELLA'S WONDER worked her way to the rail early racing under reserve behind the second flight racing to the far turn and never gained striking position.
