Footnotes

ISLE OF SKYE, bumped at the start, recovered quickly to secure the advantage along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend and was roused in upper stretch to extend his advantage, holding sway to the end under firm right handed encouragement. MOROCCAN BREW broke inwards bumping the eventual winner, was righted gain a position just off the leader in the opening stages, prompted that foe's pace racing into the turn but proved no match late in late stages while clearly second best. JOE MATT, firmly reserved outside foes in the opening stages, commenced a steady three wide advance racing through the turn and continued in that path through upper stretch while making a mild gain. GRAND SILVER worked his way to the inside early settling in the last flight, shifted off the inside to split foes entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve position in late stages. ESPRESSO, a bit outpaced early, passed some rivals in the stretch but never gained contention. WILSONS STORM tracked off the second flight near the inside early but lacked the needed closing response. MISFIRED tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing into the bend but steadily faded after a half. AMALFI RUNNER gained a position just off the pacesetter along the inside tracking that foe in the opening stages but steadily retreated after a half.
