SARA'S CAPE broke awkwardly losing position to the field at the break, moved to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, came under pressure on the far turn advancing on the leaders three deep, disputed the lead between foes in that path past midstretch and narrowly prevailed in the final stages under brisk handling. JUST WAITING settled well off the second flight while angling to the inside in the opening stages, continued unhurried for a half, steadily drew into striking distance while shifting out four deep nearing upper stretch, drew on terms with the leaders near midstretch but was just outkicked in the final sixteenth. LIME TRYST was guided to the rail while taking up a position as part of the second flight racing just out of striking distance in the opening stages, steadily drew into contention inside foes on the far turn, came through along the rail to challenge for command nearing midstretch and was just outfinished by the top pair. VIVA BERTHA settled outside a rival in the last flight racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention while angling out six wide leaving the far turn, continued in that path while drawing into striking distance near midstretch but finished evenly in the last furlong. MILESTONEMISSILE joined the pace outside a rival soon after the start, forced the issue to gain a narrow advantage after a half, set the pace along the inside through the second bend but gave way once headed in upper stretch. SOMALI BYRD sped to the fore along the inside to dispute the pace, dueled for command into the backstretch, shifted outside the pacesetter once losing the advantage on the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. POINT YOUR FINGER tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, moved to lodge a brief bid while shifting out five deep between foes nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. CHARLOTTE'S CAPE dropped out of contention early.
