Footnotes

TRIBECKY broke inwards bumping MISS MAUREEN at the start, was righted, then reserved just outside that foe racing through the backstretch while leading the second flight, lost some position to the pacesetter racing to the bend, responded readily when called upon to close the gap nearing midstretch, then continued well despite being carried out a bit late to take over and edge forward late under firm right handed pressure. MISS MAUREEN, bumped at the start, recovered quickly to move clear of her foes in the opening quarter, set the pace along the inside while under some rating racing to the turn, gained a commanding advantage after six furlongs, drifted out offering brief resistance when challenged by the winner but couldn't contain that rival. AU DIXIE tracked just off the leaders unhurried near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out a bit entering upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the top pair and finished evenly while earning a share. BELL Z GIRL, held up off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, never gained striking distance. MONA SARA was settled outside a rival in the opening stages but lacked any response when called upon racing through the bend. VICARY ROSE broke slowly, then was shuffled back out of close quarters after the start, raced well back of the field to the turn, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch but never mounted a serious challenge.
