Footnotes

THIRD CHANCE joined the pace five deep from the break, pressed the issue racing to the bend while angling inwards a bit, continued to prompt the pace outside a rival on the bend, forged clear after three furlongs and widened her advantage under steady pressure. POINT YOUR FINGER, prominent along the inside in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders after the opening furlong, angled four wide while moving to striking distance between foes entering upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved clearly best of the others. SWEET CHI TOWN tracked off the first flight racing unhurried to the bend, angled five wide entering upper stretch and continued with interest to earn a share. SUSPENDED MOON disputed the lead between foes along the rail after the opening furlong, was shut off and forced to check off foes leaving the half mile marker, then continued along the inside while continuing evenly. TURTLE PIE chased the leaders racing four wide into the turn but couldn't gain terms with the leaders and weakened in the drive. REBA NELL was settled off the inside in the opening stages and improved her position outside foes. LOST ACCOUNT tracked the pace off the inside racing to the turn but never seriously menaced. AUTUMN GLORY, unruly in the gate prior to the start, never mounted a serious challenge. TAKE MANHATTAN proved no factor. LINDSEYTOTHEMAX was roused to dispute the pace between foes from the break but dropped out early. MIDWINTER was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the outset, angled to the rail nearing the turn, continued to force the issue inside a rival racing through the bend and gave way nearing midstretch.
