Footnotes

HOT KITTEN took up a tracking position racing three deep off the second flight to the backstretch, made steady progress outside foes to challenge four deep leaving the second bend, then wrested command and edged forward in the final stages to prevail under firm handling. GROOM CHASER tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight in the opening half, continued in that path to challenge between foes nearing upper stretch, couldn't match terms with

the winner but secured second late. CALLALOO broke inwards bumping MS TRANSFORMATIONS, was collected off that foe to track off the second flight along the inside to the far turn, shifted out splitting foes nearing upper stretch and produced her best stride late to earn a share racing five deep in the lane. POCKET MISS moved to the fore along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, edged forward to a brief advantage entering upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum. LIVE TODAY tracked the leaders in second flight along the rail to the far turn, saved ground through the second bend while awaiting an opening, then lost position in the final stages while blocked behind a weakening rival in the last furlong. LIGHT MY SAPHIRE was guided to the rail soon after the break, then saved ground throughout while continuing evenly. HAWAIIAN CONCH, bumped at the start, recovered quickly to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, took a few erratic steps after a half, pressed the issue racing into the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. SHE'S A GRINDER broke outwards bumping HAWAIIAN CONCH, was settled along the inside but never gained contention. WILMINGTON tracked the leaders between foes off the second flight to the backstretch but dropped out racing through the far turn. MS TRANSFORMATIONS, bumped at the start, was switched outside foes while urged to gain a contending position, made a brief, three wide bid nearing the far turn but gave way early.
