**Footnotes**

MAD FLATTER moved to gain command near the inside in the opening furlong, dictated the pace under light rating, then responded when roused clear in upper stretch to extend his advantage to the end. LIBERTY BULL tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail as part of the second flight, continued with a steady effort inside a rival to gain even terms on the wire for the place while proving no menace to the winner. HE'S BONAFIDE angled inwards to stalk just off the pacesetter while under some reserve, couldn't maintain terms with that foe after six furlongs but continued well enough to finish on even terms with a rival for the place. BROTHERS NICHOLAS, held up behind the second flight in the opening half, split foes racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. PINE MAST tracked the leaders three wide behind the second flight, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. BILL OF BILLS lost his blinkers not long after the start, tracked the leaders outside a rival as part of the second flight but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. RECTOR switched off the inside soon after the break while under some pressure to gain a position between foes in the second flight but retreated from contention early. CHARLIE BABY was settled along the inside in the opening stages but never gained striking distance. UNBRIDLED VICAR never

seriously menaced.
