TOWERING SWORD stalked the pace from just outside, rallied to the lead in the stretch and drew off late. FULL MANDATE saved ground near the middle of the field, steadied in the stretch when he ran up on a rivals and rallied for the place when clear. PRIVATE RANSOM raced near the middle of the field and rallied to loom a threat in the stretch but flattened out. SILENT FLICK raced close up but lacked a rally. FLEMISH CAP set the pace from the rail and weakened. A TABLE FOR THREE was never a factor. DARING ADVENTURE raced close up inside and tired. MUSGROVE MILL was always outrun. JUST GOSSIP was also outrun. TAKE THE A TRAIN raced near the middle of the field and tired. DIXIE SKY broke slowly and trailed throughout.
