YORONA, carried inwards a bit just after the start, secured a tracking position along the inside racing just off the leaders under some reserve, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch while being urged to challenge and narrowly prevailed in the final strides under firm left handed encouragement. MAGIC CHAPEL was urged between foes to secure a forward placing from the break, tracked just off the pacesetter racing to the turn, moved to challenge between foes racing through upper stretch and was just outkicked. CHAPA RITA shifted inwards at the start while being urged to the lead, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, held sway past the sixteenth marker but yielded to the top pair late. INCA MISS settled off the second flight in early stages, split foes nearing upper stretch while being urged to contention, angled four wide leaving the three sixteenths marker but had no final response. HUGE HOPE tracked the leaders along the inside from off the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked a response in the final quarter. BLUEGRASSKITTEN, bumped at the start, settled in last racing to the bend and offered no rally. BABY WILDCAT bobbled at the start, then bumped a rival, was urged to secure a forward placing four wide in the opening furlong, continued three deep on the bend and steadily faded after a half. AAHBREEZE was in brief contention three deep between foes racing to the turn but emptied out after the opening quarter.
