Footnotes

CITY NUMBER exchanged bumps with TWYLAS RED CAT at the break, was reserved in hand while angling to the inside racing through the bend, saved ground on the turn gathering momentum after a half, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch to split foes while being urged to challenge, wrested command nearing the sixteenth marker and drew away under strong handling. DOONEY ROCK, reserved while making his way to the inside racing to the turn, saved ground on the bend, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and followed the winner's path to the wire while making steady progress between foes to secure second near the wire. MY MAN JAY, shuffled a bit in close quarters after the start, tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, angled out four wide nearing the quarter mile marker while moving to challenge, shifted inwards in upper stretch while gaining brief command nearing the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the top pair late. GALLOPING GULCH shifted out at the break, was righted to track the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, steadily drew into contention along the rail on the turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted out to bid between foes racing through the stretch but lacked the needed final kick. TWYLAS RED CAT exchanged some contact with the eventual winner at the start, was shuffled a bit when caught in close quarters just after the break, was urged to a position between foes in the second flight, angled five wide in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. GREY KNIGHT was hustled to secure terms with a rival on the pace, attended the tempo racing into the

bend, was urged to press the issue racing into upper stretch and gave way once headed leaving the furlong marker. ROYALLY OUTFOXED tracked off the second flight five wide in early stages, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch while gaining some position but made no impression on the leaders. LUCKY MERLOT, slow into stride, never gained contention. APPLESOLUTELY WILD, close up three wide in early stages, chased the leaders in that path through the turn and steadily faded after a half. CROOK'S BODGIT was never a factor. CONVOY AHEAD angled in sharply soon after the break while being urged to join the pace, forced the issue outside a rival racing into the turn and emptied out abruptly in upper stretch.
