GUTIEREZ GIRL moved to the fore along the rail racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin while in hand racing to the far turn, forged clear when given her cue entering upper stretch and extended her advantage to the end under steady hand urging. PERFECT STRANGER secured a position just off the first flight along the rail while pulling her rider a bit racing to the backstretch, came through inside foes to challenge entering upper stretch but proved only second best. LOOKINATMINDY, off a bit awkwardly, settled into stride along the inside, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. TONZIE, allowed to settle in last racing to the far turn, saved ground on the second bend and improved her position inside foes racing into the stretch while never seriously menacing. GOSTOSA, forwardly placed from the break, attended the pace between foes through the backstretch, couldn't match terms with the winner nearing upper stretch and gave way. HOIST THE COLORS, in close attendance to the pace three deep early, made a brief bid in that path racing into the far turn and emptied out. SUNDAY TEA BREAK, held up from just out of striking distance racing in the three pace on the first turn, never mounted a serious challenge.
