POETS AND ANGELS set the pace from the inside while pressed and prevailed gamely in the drive. LANLICIA raced three wide from the middle of the field, switched to the rail for the drive and rallied but missed. BAYANI lacked speed, angled out and gained belatedly. BRIDGET SAYS lacked speed four to five wide and rallied to loom a threat in the stretch but faltered late. GRAVELLONA T raced close up but weakened. COMBAT SOLDIER pressed the pace just outside and tired. DOUBLE HALO raced three to four wide and was not a factor. INIS saved ground but pulled up in the stretch and was vanned off. (Race run in lane 2, rail at 0.)
