Footnotes

SURELY IRISH moved to the lead near the inside, dictated a comfortable pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, shook clear entering upper stretch and maintained her advantage to the end under firm encouragement. ALBANY INDIAN, reserved outside a rival in the last flight early, shifted outside foes leaving the second bend gathering momentum, was fanned six wide racing through the stretch but produced a solid late response to close the gap on the winner and narrowly prevail for the place. DEAR GOLDIE tracked just off the second flight outside a rival under some reserve in the opening half, advanced three deep nearing upper stretch, closed the gap on the winner between foes in that path in late stages but was outfinished for place honors. SUPERSTARDOM, a bit rank under restraint while guided to the rail in the opening half, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch to bid between foes but had no final response. LUCKY GAL tracked the pace unhurried behind the second flight along the inside to the backstretch, shifted out a bit awaiting an opening racing into upper stretch, angled four wide in late stages but was outkicked. OUR GIRL MAGIC was settled along the inside racing to the backstretch and never gained striking distance. PAT'S RIDGE, brushed by SUPERSTARDOM at the break, bobbled just after the start, was quickly righted to gain a stalking position just outside the pacesetter, briefly pressed the leader after six furlongs but quickly came up empty.
