Footnotes

PETERS ROCK angled to the rail early tracking just off the first flight, saved ground to upper stretch, then came through close quarters to challenge inside the leaders leaving the furlong marker to narrowly prevail under firm handling. GRAND SENSATION, held up along the rail while caught in some close quarters early, tracked off the second flight saving ground racing into the bend, shifted out with a sharp move in upper stretch making some contact with UPSELL but continued with interest to split foes three deep and contest the issue to the end. JOST VAN DYKE settled into stride to stride a bit off the inside racing into the turn, angled out six wide entering upper stretch and was making steady late progress while gaining a share. UNCLE JEEP tracked off the second flight between foes racing into the turn and gained some position late despite being caught in traffic through the stretch. TOASTMASTER, in touch with the pacesetter early, conceded the lead racing into the turn while shifting outside that rival, made a brief bid between foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. NO RULES NOW was urged to gain a forward placing three wide between foes, lost some position racing in close quarters through the turn to upper stretch and continued evenly through late stages. BULLET FROM ABROAD was urged to the lead from between foes, angled to the rail once establishing the advantage, duelled for command inside foes to upper stretch and emptied out late. UPSELL, urged to contend four deep in the opening stages, steadily faded racing into upper stretch while being bumped in the closing stages. KEYITE (ARG) broke slowly and trailed throughout.
