Footnotes

SMARTY BOY broke readily to gain the advantage near the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin inside under light rating racing to the far turn, was roused racing into upper stretch to gain a clear advantage and just held ALPHA KITALPHA under pressure. The latter was reserved between foes in the opening half, shifted out of close quarters while gathering momentum on the far turn, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch and made steady progress to the end to gain the place honors while failing to edge the winner. SLAMMERBDANCING angled inwards to track the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight to the far turn, was urged to challenge along the inside racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while earning a share. AWOL ADAM was settled last to the far turn, shifted out racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress splitting foes three deep in the closing stages. COCO MON, caught five wide racing to the backstretch while being rated off the second flight, was urged to challenge four deep between foes nearing upper stretch but finished evenly late. EIGHT GAUGE, pulling a bit along the inside while tracking off the second flight racing into the backstretch, saved ground throughout while gaining some position late but made no real impression. MY BORSALINO was urged to gain a position three deep between foes in the second flight, lodged a brief bid between rivals in that path on the far turn but flattened out in the drive. I'M STILL THE KING was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. SERGEANT C BROWN broke slowly, was held up off the second flight while shifting out early, commenced an early move five deep racing into the far turn to gain contention nearing upper stretch but proved empty in the drive. HOT HEAD tracked the pace between foes the second flight under some prompting to contend in the opening half and steadily faded while racing in close quarters into the stretch. PALE HOSE, caught four deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued outside foes to the second bend and

steadily retreated into upper stretch.
