DA MAMA saved ground early, angled out in the turn then ran down the leader and stayed on. SUMMER FLIGHT was always close off the rail, took the lead in the lane, weakened but held the place. ELUSIVE SPARKLE hit the gate then had a late rally between horses. MEGAWATTIE split horses in the turn, steadied and was shut off in the stretch and missed for a share. LUNE ROUGE steadied and was rank early, raced far back early and was no threat. GOLDINTHEPOCKET set a pressured pace then gave way inside. DOWNTOWN DRIFTER was through early, raced widest in the drive and was erratic. KIP BERRIES was unruly in the gate, took the lead in the turn and stopped in the stretch. RACE RUN IN LANE 5.
