TIZ MIZ SUE led throughout, was unchallenged in the stretch and was much the best while in hand. CHASING THE QUEEN was placed forwardly, made up ground on the turn but was no match for the winner. BELL'S SHOES was unhurried early, angled in and had a mild rally during the stretch run but drifted out late. IDEALHOUSE saved ground and failed to menace. IM A CLASSY CAT stumbled at the start, stalked the pace but failed to sustain the bid. SHARP CURRENT was through early and always outrun. MISS GOLD COAST had no speed and was never involved. PICK AND PRAY was unprepared at the start, broke outward, was rank and not a factor.
