**Footnotes**

SUNSHINE EXPRESS gained a position just off the leader stalking that foe a bit off the inside in the opening stages, shifted to the rail on the turn commencing a steady advance, shifted outside the pacesetter while moving to wrest command in upper stretch and drew clear late under firm encouragement. DOUBLE SILVER was urged to the lead from the break while shifting sharply to the rail, dictated the pace to upper stretch but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. NO LIP was roused in the opening stages to gain a contending position, tracked off the second flight along the inside racing into the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing. TRIPLE OVERTIME tracked just off the first flight three deep in the opening stages, was urged to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. BIGTIME MAC, forwardly placed prompting the pacesetter in the opening stages, steadily retreated after a half. SHERIFF MAX settled into stride off the inside in early stages and never seriously menaced. SERVICE DUTY HONOR settled into stride along the rail early and never menaced thereafter.
