LOOSENTHESECONDARY broke readily to gain the advantage along the inside, dictated the pace racing into the the bend, turned back a challenge nearing upper stretch to reestablish a clear margin and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. BACKSTREET HERO broke slowly, then was bumped by RICHARD'S TUNE, settled in hand in last along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out on the turn to advance on the leaders four deep, then continued outside foes through the stretch to secure place honors while failing to gain terms with the winner. WILD SLEW, urged along inside foes racing as part of the second flight, couldn't match terms with the top pair but continued evenly near the inside to late stages to earn a share. VINO LIMBO TANGO tracked the pace between foes in the second flight and continued evenly into the stretch. J EVANS tracked off the second flight along the rail in the opening stages, continued in hand on the turn briefly awaiting an opening, then made an effort to improve his position near the inside racing through the stretch. RICHARD'S TUNE broke inwards bumping a rival, was righted to track off the second flight three deep racing into the bend and steadily faded in late stages. COTTON WON forwardly placed while widest in the opening stages, shifted in nearing the bend to briefly prompt the pacesetter approaching upper stretch but failed to sustain that effort through the last quarter. JOHNNY HANDSOME broke a step slowly, settled outside foes early, then continued three deep between foes on the turn while offering no rally. WEALTH MANAGEMENT, urged along between foes in the opening stages, dropped out of contention early.
