POETIC KID was reserved saving ground racing just out of striking distance in the opening stages, made a steady advance to contention on her own courage racing into the far turn, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch while moving to challenge between foes, wrested command with a sharp move and drew clear late under firm encouragement. PENELOPE PERFECT, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter racing into the backstretch, continued with a steady bid to gain the advantage nearing midstretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. KITCHEN BOSS, bumped, then shuffled back at the start, was reserved in last collecting her stride in the opening stages, shifted off the inside in upper stretch and split foes racing through the lane while making some belated progress to gain a share. BETHANY BELLE broke inwards bumping JAZZ BEAT, was righted, then urged to the lead along the inside, dictated the pace into the second bend, briefly resisted when challenged but gave way leaving midstretch. JAZZ BEAT, bumped, then forced into KITCHEN BOSS at the start, was righted to track the pacesetter along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out three deep after a half commencing an early advance on the pacesetter, pressed the issue in that path into the far turn but quickly came up empty while being fanned four wide into the stretch. INDYGO KISS settled outside a rival early and never gained contention.
