YUKAN B A LADY TOO lacked speed while off the rail, rallied in the middle of the course and drew off late. WERRA stalked the pace from off the rail then was no match for the winner in the drive while lasting for the place. SAND TRICK lacked speed while just outside, came farther out for the drive and rallied belatedly. BLUFFER raced close up and made a bid to contention in the stretch but faltered late. BLUSHING CALLER set the pace on a clear lead but weakened. PRESIDENTIAL POWER was never a factor. MONEY CLIP improved her position in the drive. DOWAGER LADY raced close up inside and tired. I BE SHY was always outrun. DIABLO'S HEIRESS raced close up but gave way. SWEEPING HOURS raced close up inside and tired.
