LOST AT SEA raced in close attendance of the pace while three wide, responded when asked for her best to challenge for the lead in the stretch then edged away under urging. SEE HOW SHE RUNS broke to the lead and established a rail position, set the pace from the rail and grudgingly gave ground to the winner in the drive. STRIKES NO SPARES was allowed to settle in off the rail near the middle of the field, rallied in the stretch and gained minor awards without threatening the top two. SARATOGA CAT was void of early speed while saving ground and could only improve her position in the drive. SUMMER MIS pressed the pace from just outside and put a head in front on the final turn but tired in the run to the wire. BELVEDERE MISS raced near the middle of the field and was through early. MS BROOKSKI stumbled at the start to be last away and trailed throughout.
