AROARABLE raced close up off the rail, rallied to the front and drew off late. LA BARONESS set the pace from off the rail while pressed but could not go with the winner in the drive. VICAR'S DAUGHTER pressed the pace from the rail and lacked a winning bid. ROUSES POINT lacked speed off the rail, made a bid in the stretch and flattened out. DORELLA lacked speed three wide and showed little. SUMMER'S LULLABY saved ground but was always outrun. SCARLET BLUE raced off the rail near the middle of the field and gave way.
