ALASKAN HULA was fractious in the gate, saved ground the entire way and got through on the rail in the stretch to go onto the win. PYRAMYST set the pace while in hand, led into the stretch then came off the rail and was caught late. ALEDO MAGIC was allowed to settle, contended while four wide on the turn and made a steady advance to be third. GOLDEN HAIR loomed boldly through the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch but made no late rally. WHEN MO MONEY got off slowly and checked repeatedly through the opening half then was taken off the rail and was six wide on the turn but made no rally. COUNT SHEEP rated in the middle of the pack between horses, lacked room in the turn and tired stretch. PAW PRINTS raced in the second flight, was asked in the turn but had no response.
