Footnotes

TOUCH OF REVENGE was settled in hand outside a rival racing out of striking distance in the opening stages, shifted to the inside nearing the turn, pulled her way to contention between foes on her own courage nearing upper stretch, made some light contact with GALETOIRE while steadily drawing on terms with the leader in the lane and edged ZUNI WOMEN in late stages under energetic handling while being carried out by that foe late. The latter, stalked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out to press between foes leaving the turn, gained a clear advantage between calls in upper stretch, then resisted the winner's bid to the end while drifting out under pressure in late stages but proved only second best. GALETOIRE tracked the pacesetter between foes in second flight in the opening stages, lodged a brief, three wide bid leaving the turn, was brushed by the eventual winner entering upper stretch and lacked the needed final response while continuing well enough to earn a share. DESIRE TO CHANGE tracked the pace four wide in second flight racing to the turn and came up empty nearing upper stretch. GOTTA DANCE, a bit outpaced along the inside early, never gained contention. GOLDEN HYMN ducked into the gap at the start, was quickly righted, then urged to secure the lead along the inside, set the pace racing into the bend and was spent after a half.
