HIGH POTENTIAL lacked speed just outside, angled off the rail in the stretch and rallied for a late decision. NEST raced just outside near the middle of the field, split horses in the stretch and rallied to the lead but could not last. REASON TO TALK raced inside, dropped back on the final turn then rallied belatedly for a share. BALLA TWINE vied for the lead inside and weakened. OVAL improved her position in the drive. GLORY GLORY contested the pace just outside and tired. AMBITIOUS (NZ) made a bid on the backstretch but faltered in the drive. BELLA VILLA was always outrun.
